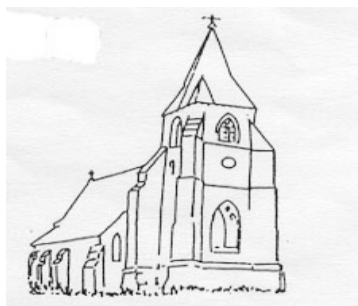

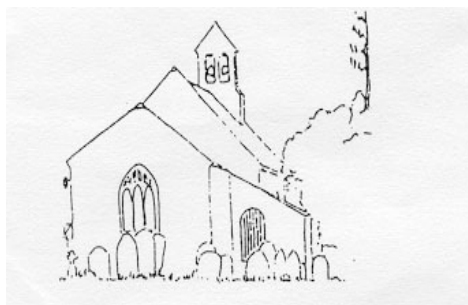
St John, Bilsdale Midcable



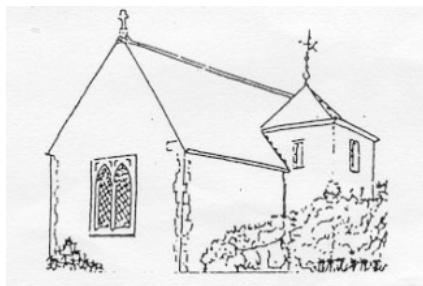

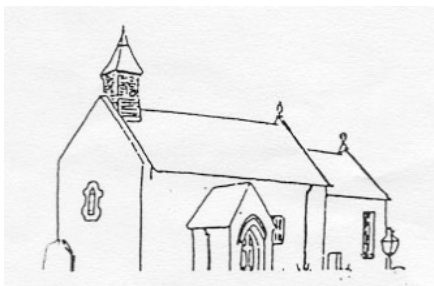


All Saints, Hawby

five Free French Airmen who were killed when their Halifax bomber crashed on its way back to Elvington airfield on 15 March 1945.
